Ornamental Aluminum	This discipline will be taught as part of the Capstone project below.

Welding	Shop class building for chainlink and frame for wood gate
Gate Operators	Service four gate operators with various requirements as well as install new operator.
Farm and Ranch	Construct several sections of coated high tensile fence with a hydraulic pounder.
Wood	50' of 6' high dog ear solid fence with 5' gate.
PVC	Repair 6' high vinyl fence damaged by the hurricane. Install 60' of new fence.
Blueprints	Review basics of reviewing blueprints and generating materials required
